SERVICE AND PHILANTHROPY

Since its inception in 1907, members have generously given their time and financial support to improve the lives of their neighbors in Westport and greater Fairfield County.

The Community Services Committee embodies the core values of the Westport Woman’s Club and evaluates grant applications from area non-profit organizations each year. Additionally, the committee oversees service projects that members participate in. Homelessness, family crises, and food insecurity are some of the social needs addressed.

Over the past decade, over \$486,600 in Community Service Grants have been awarded by the Westport Woman’s Club!

FOOD CLOSET

In 1975, the Westport Woman’s Club started an Emergency Food Distribution Program, under the leadership of the Westport Department of Human Services. It is now known as the Food Closet and continues to this day. Westport Woman’s Club volunteers and donors provide over five hundred bags of non-perishable food each year to individuals and families in need.

Additionally, the Westport Woman’s Club donates holiday meals and grocery store gift cards to allow families in need to purchase perishable food items like eggs, milk, and bread.

The Westport Woman’s Club's commitment to service and philanthropy remains an integral part of our mission.

RUEGG GRANT HISTORY

The Ruegg Grant was established in 1995 by an endowment bequeathed to the Westport Woman's Club by member Lea Ruegg. Proposals are solicited and reviewed by a Woman's Club appointed committee. The award is given annually to a non-profit organization for a project that will provide a lasting benefit to the community. Past recipients have been involved in the arts, education, public health, and safety-related programs. To date, over \$200,000 has been awarded to the following organizations:

1996 Curry Fresco Restoration Committee - to restore two John Steuart Curry Frescos "Comedy and Tragedy" located in the Kings Highway School auditorium. \$9,600

1996 The Connecticut Theater Foundation - Operator of the Westport Country Playhouse, to co-sponsor a world premiere of the musical, "Snapshots," during the summer season. \$10,000

2019 Aspetuck Land Trust - Sponsor "Green Corridor: Saugatuck to Shore" program \$10,000

2023 Positive Directions – The Center for Prevention and Counseling – Quarterly mental wellness fairs - \$6,000

COMMUNITY IMPACT

In 2022, the Westport Woman’s Club and an anonymous member, pledged \$300,000 to the Westport Volunteer Emergency Medical Service to purchase a new ambulance.



SCHOLARSHIPS & STUDENT GRANTS

The first scholarship was awarded in 1925, and each year thereafter a special community services scholarship committee consulted with Staples High School to decide on a designee. The amount and number of general scholarships vary by year according to the funding available and the qualifications of the applicants. Over the past ten years, Westport Woman’s Club has awarded \$336,500 in Scholarships and \$10,000 in Grants.

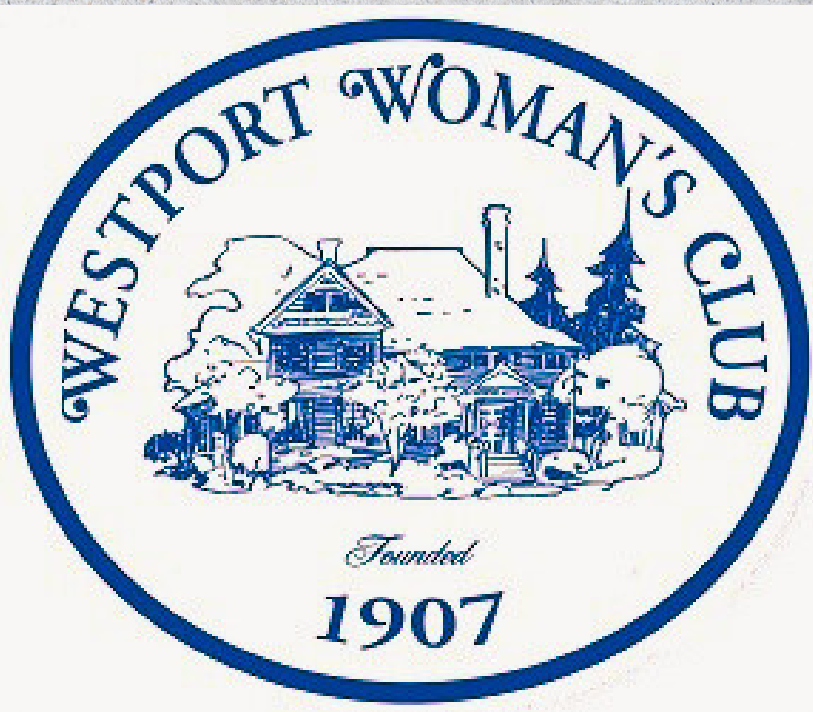
